31 of the U.N. Convention on the Rights of the Child.

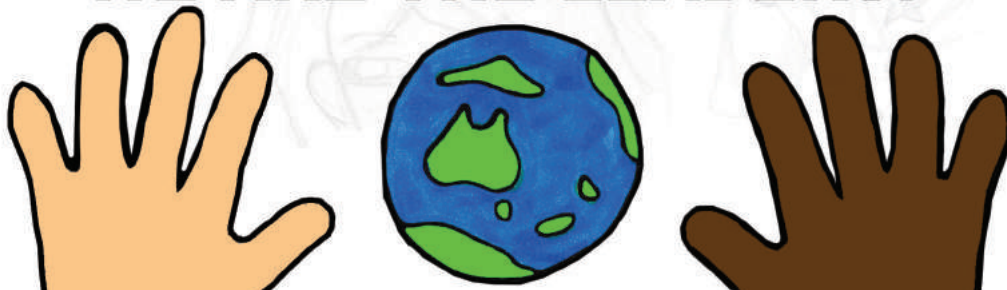




Message from Aunty Paula...




Being creative is the best feeling in the world. It makes me feel like I can do anything and everything.


Being creative means being me, expressing who I am.

Materials:

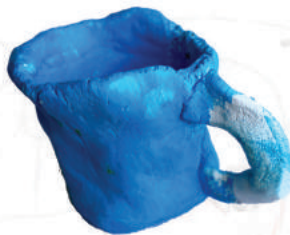
Clay (you can make your own clay at home)
